We plan a Scenic Social run on Saturday 17th for those wishing to join us OR you can do your own thing, there is much to see and do in the surrounding area.

The main event is on Sunday 18th July, you can pre-order on your entry form for Sunday a Full English or Bacon Rolls plus Ham or Cheese Ploughman's lunch etc. for when we return at lunchtime.

After lunch we go out again returning for tea/cake, awards presentations, raffle etc.

The event raises much needed funds for Dorset and Somerset Air Ambulance, the club has donated in excess of £24000.00 over the last nine events, many thanks go to our sponsors and brochure advertisers and the entrants.

From 2007 to 2010 the club held a Tortoise Run based on the Somerset Levels which ran from Eli,s the popular public house in Huish Episcopi near Langport.

The idea was to try and encourage some of the older bikes and their riders to take part in a leisurely ride of about 40 miles for the day on fairly level ground, these events met with moderate success.

For the clubs 10th anniversary year, Club chairman Chris Weeks offered to take the run back to our home town of Wells and make it into a "Tortoise and Hare Run" which would open the event to all bikes and scooters. This meant quite a lot of extra organising and the event was a great success, the event has followed the same successful format to date, we change the Coffee stop location each year so as to enable us to alter the routes for the entrants enjoyment, taking in some of the finest viewing points that the area has to offer.

For 2014 we included a" Snail Route" which is for Veterans and very low powered machines, this extra route allowed us to extend the Tortoise run into more of the Mendip Hills and surrounding countryside.
